**Pursuant to Section 551.043, Government Code**  
**November 2025**

*BUDGET STATEMENT Pursuant to Section 551.043, Government Code, the following taxpayer impact statement must be included with the City Council meeting notice at which the City Council will discuss or adopt a budget for the City of Annetta South: For an average-valued homestead property, the City's portion of the property tax bill in dollars for the current fiscal year (FY2025) is \$0, the City's portion of the property tax bill for the upcoming fiscal year (FY2026) for the same property if the proposed budget is adopted is estimated to be \$0, and the City's portion of the property tax bill in dollars for the upcoming fiscal year (FY2026) for the same property if a budget funded at the no-new-revenue rate under Chapter 26, Tax Code, is adopted is estimated to be \$0.*
