

ORDINANCE NO. 040

AN ORDINANCE ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF MARSHAL AND CONFERRING THE DUTIES OF THE MARSHAL ON A MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICER APPOINTED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OR ANY OTHER PEACE OFFICER OF THE COUNTY.

WHEREAS, there is currently no person elected to serve as Marshal for the Town of Annetta South; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen desires, as permitted by section 22.076(b) of the Texas Local Government Code, to abolish the office of Marshal; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN, TOWN OF ANNETTA SOUTH, TEXAS:


Section 1: THAT the office of Marshal be and the same is hereby abolished.

Section 2: THAT the duties of the office of Marshal are hereby conferred on a municipal police officer appointed by the Board.


AND IT IS SO ORDERED.
