

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE APPLICATION OF
ALL SUBDIVISION REQUIREMENTS OF THE CITY
OF ANNETTA SOUTH, TEXAS, TO THE EXTRATERRI-
TORIAL JURISDICTION OF SAID CITY, WITHIN
THE MEANING AND TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED BY
SECTIONS 4 AND 5 OF THE TEXAS MUNICIPAL AN-
NEXATION ACT (ARTICLE 970a, TEXAS REVISED
CIVIL STATUTES)


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANNETTA
SOUTH, TEXAS:

1. That the application of all subdivision require-
ments of the City of Annetta South, Texas, as contained in
any ordinances, rules or regulations of said City as now ex-
isting and as hereafter amended and/or adopted, be and same
are hereby extended to the area under and within the extra-
territorial jurisdiction of the City of Annetta South, Texas,
within the meaning and to the full extent provided and per-
mitted by Sections 4 and 5 of the Texas Municipal Annexation
Act (Article 970a, Texas Revised Civil Statutes).


2. Violations of any subdivision requirements of the
City of Annetta South under this ordinance - that is, viola-
tions occurring without the corporate limits of the City, but
within its extraterritorial jurisdiction as established by the
Texas Municipal Annexation Act - shall not constitute a misde-
meanor under any ordinance of the City, nor shall any fine be
assessed for such violations within the extraterritorial jur-
isdiction. The City of Annetta South, however, shall have the
right to institute suit in the district court to enjoin any
such violation, and said court shall have the power to grant
injunctive relief therefor, as provided in Section 4, of the
Texas Municipal Annexation Act.

3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect
immediately upon its adoption and approval.
