

ORDINANCE NO. 48

WHEREAS, the regular election for City Council of the City of Annetta South, as set forth by the Texas Election Code, is required to be held on May 1, 1999, at which time the voters will elect City Council Places 1, 2 and 4; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANNETTA SOUTH, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT an election is hereby called to elect City Council Places 1, 2 and 4 to serve until May of 2001, or until their successors are duly elected and qualified. Such election shall be held at 6011 F.M. Rd 5, Aledo, Texas 76008, on the 1st day of May, 1999, from 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m.

Section 2: Qualified persons may file as candidates by filing applications for City Council Places 1, 2 and 4 at 501 Hilldale, Aledo, Texas 76008, from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. on weekdays from February 15, 1999, through March 17, 1999.

Section 3: Early voting shall commence at 501 Hilldale, Aledo, Texas 76008, on April 14, 1999, and shall continue Monday through Friday from 6:00 p.m. until 9:00 p.m. until April 27, 1999.

Section 4: The following persons shall be the officers who shall conduct the election:

Sue Brown - Presiding Judge

Doris Meadows - Alternate Presiding Judge


and no more than six (6) eligible persons as clerks whom the election judge shall appoint. The persons named above shall also serve as the early voting ballot board.

Section 5: The election shall be conducted according to the election laws of the State of Texas.


