

SECTION 1. THAT THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF ALEXANDRIA BE AND IT IS HEREBY
AMENDED BY ADDING THE FOLLOWING SECTION TO THE CHARTER:

ARTICLE 8. THE TOWN OF ALEXANDRIA, THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA AND THE CITY
TOWN OF PINE GROVE, COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE PURCHASED LANDS, COMBINE
TO FORM THE CITY OF ALEXANDRIA.

SECTION 1A. AN ELECTION WITH THREE VOTING STATION HAS BEEN AUTHORIZED FOR
2006 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL MEMBERS AND
TOWN COUNCIL MEMBERS ON THE CITY SIDE OF THE TOWN OF ALEXANDRIA, SOUTH DAKOTA.

SECTION 1B. NO PROPOSITION TO APPROVE THE TOWN SIDE TAXES SHALL BE

SECTION 1C. THE CITY SIDE TAXES SHALL NOT BE USED FOR THE PURCHASED LANDS.
THE PURCHASED LANDS WILL NOT RECEIVE TAXES FROM THE CITY SIDE.

SECTION 1D. THE CITY SIDE TAXES SHALL NOT BE USED FOR THE PURCHASED LANDS IN
EXCESS OF THE PURCHASED LANDS.

SECTION 1E. IN THE OFFICER BALANCE / Councillor C OR Councillor D OR Councillor E
WHENEVER A GOVERNING BODY OF OFFICERS AND COUNCILS ARE MOVED, RE-ELECTED,
RE-OFFICING, OR FOR THE ELECTION. **NOW, THEREFORE,**

**SECTION 2. PROVIDED THAT THE CITY COUNCIL, THE TOWN OF ALEXANDRIA,
SOUTH DAKOTA,**

Section 1. THAT THE OFFICING COUNCILS, WHO ARE NOT LISTED IN THE MAY
15, 2006 GENERAL ELECTION, AND NOT YET DECLARED ELECTED TO OFFICE,
SHALL NOT BE ISSUED ANY FORMS OF DOCUMENTS.
