

ORDINANCE NO. 68

AN ORDINANCE CANCELLING THE MAY 14, 2011, REGULAR ELECTION OF THE CITY OF ANNETTA SOUTH, TEXAS AND DECLARING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ELECTED TO OFFICE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Annetta South, Texas is a Type A general-law municipality located in Parker County, operating pursuant to the enabling legislation of the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with law a general election has been ordered for May 14, 2011 for the purpose of electing council members to serve on the city council in the City of Annetta South; and

WHEREAS, no proposition is to appear on the ballot in that election; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor's Assistant has certified in writing that each candidate on the ballot is unopposed for the election to office; and

WHEREAS, the filing deadlines for placement on the ballot and declaration of write-in candidacy have passed; and

WHEREAS, in these circumstances Subchapter C of Chapter 2 of the Election Code authorizes a governing body to declare each unopposed candidate elected to office and cancel the election; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANNETTA SOUTH, TEXAS:

Section 1: THAT the following candidates, who are unopposed in the May 14, 2011 General election, are hereby declared elected to office, and shall be issued a certificate of election:

Place 1-Philip Kuntz

Place 4-David Goolsby

Section 2: The Assistant to the Mayor is directed to post a copy of this ordinance at each designated polling place on May 14, 2011.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force an effect immediately upon passage.
